

CHMS COVID Travel Policy
Updated 7/20/2022

As we go into our third year of Covid we know that increased vaccination rates and lesser restrictions are encouraging more family travel. The evolving CDC and state and local government guidelines may require further adjustment of our policies.

While there are currently no travel restrictions by the CDC, we request those traveling **overseas** to follow these guidelines:

Upon return to school, we require:

- A negative COVID test for your child; home tests are accepted
- Send an email to the school with a picture of your child's negative test results
- Application of the Department of Health testing and quarantining policies as stated in our "Returning to School after Illness Policy" if anyone in the household had known direct exposure to COVID.
